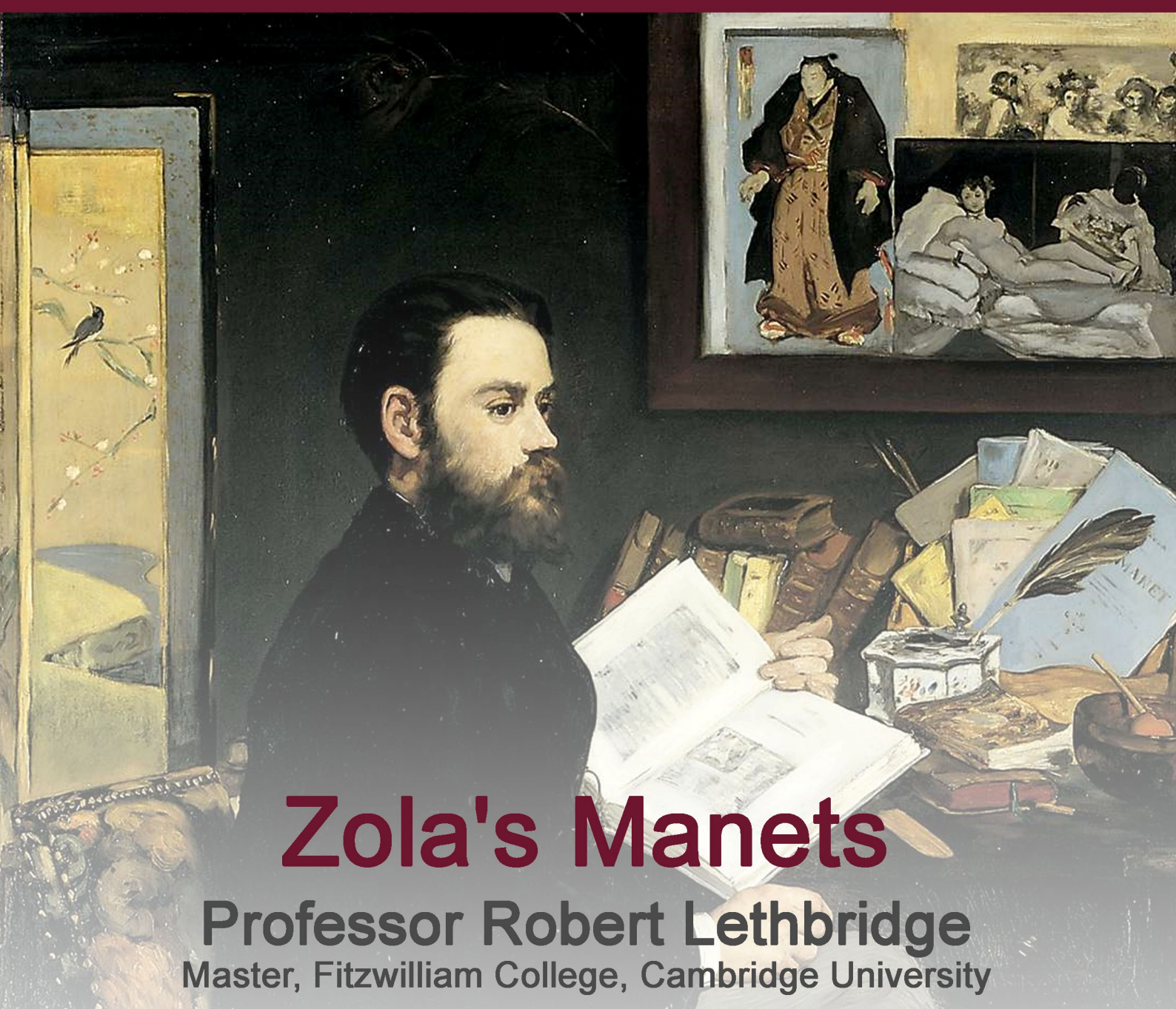

Zola's Manets

Professor Robert Lethbridge

Master, Fitzwilliam College, Cambridge University

Professor Robert Lethbridge, Emeritus Professor of French Language & Literature in the University of London and former director of the University of London Institute in Paris, is a specialist in nineteenth century French literature. He is currently Honorary Professor in the University of Cambridge. A founding member of the Society of Dix-Neuvièmistes, he has published widely on Zola, Maupassant, Naturalism, and nineteenth-century French painting. In "Zola's Manets", he will consider possessions, possessiveness and reading between the disciplines in a discussion of Zola's art-collection and the pluralities of ownership in the author's complex relationship with Manet.
