

**Professor Robert Mayhew elected
Fellow of the Society of Antiquaries of London**

[Robert Mayhew](#) has been elected a Fellow of the Society of Antiquaries of London for his "pioneering work on geographical description in the 17th and 18th centuries". The Society, founded in 1707, is dedicated to 'the encouragement, advancement and furtherance of the study and knowledge of the antiquities and history of this and other countries'. Professor of Historical Geography and Intellectual History, Robert Mayhew was also recently awarded a prestigious British Academy/Leverhulme Senior Research Fellowship to fund his current research on Thomas Robert Malthus and the history of Malthusianism. The work is an intellectual history of the intersections of environmental history and public policy over the past two centuries. Robert was one of only eight people to be awarded one of these fellowships nationally.
