

New International Cemetery, Hankow (Hankou)

This is a list of the British graves in this cemetery, compiled by 'Mr Kress', a German subject who was responsible for the International Cemetery and Trust before his departure from China in 1954. He compiled this list from the burial register before the Cemetery was handed over to the local Land Bureau in March 1954. It was sent to British diplomats and is preserved in British Foreign Office file FO 369/5018, [Public Records Office](#).

The covering note (Peking Semi/Official No.15, 2 April 1954) states that 'Mr Kress informs us that the old International Cemetery in Hankow, which he believes to have been established "many years before 1900", is to be moved to Hanyang. ... The location of the register of graves of the old International Cemetery is not known to Mr Kress, although he believes it may be packed with the files of the United States Consulate-General.'

Some of the names may have been incorrectly transcribed by Kress. The notes appear to be in French, and I have updated some of these.
