Driving instructions to Oldbury House

Turn off the M4 and onto the M32 heading South towards Bristol city centre. After the 'end of motorway' signs and the end of the bus lane, you come towards some traffic lights. Get into the right-hand lane. Go straight on. Follow the road straight on [with little jiggles and further traffic lights] and then veer to the right and through some lights at a pedestrian crossing. As you approach a large roundabout with lights, be in the middle lane [not counting bus lane]. Go more-or-less straight on, taking the second exit from the roundabout. This will take you past the bus station and magistrates court [on your left] and hospitals [both sides of the road, including childrens' hospital with large coloured hoops on a sort of tree on your right]. You will come across four sets of lights. The first are just after the bus station. Go straight on. The second comes just round the corner. Go straight on. The third set is by the A&E entrance to the hospital and the hoops. Go straight on but be in the right-hand lane to then turn right up a steep hill [St Michael's Hill] at the fourth set. Note that St Michael's Hill continues straight on up - do not follow the road round to the right. When the hill begins to flatten out somewhat, you will see a large grey concrete building on your left. Passing that grey building on your left, turn left into the road [St Michael's Park] between that building and our own [beige, 17th century] and then first right [Osbourne Villas] and right again to enter the car park, either of the two spaces marked 'DEPT'. Exit the car park up the couple of steps on the right and ring the video entry phone by the back door.
