



Postgraduate Study in the Faculty of Arts

Read-Tuckwell Postgraduate Research Scholarship

The current value of the scholarship is £3,500. UK, EU and overseas students are eligible. **All students applying for this award must be working on some aspect of Human Immortality.** Students applying for this award should be either enrolled on a postgraduate research programme at the University of Bristol or in receipt of an offer of a place on such a programme.

How to apply:

Unless you are an incoming or current student at the Department of Theology and Religious Studies in Bristol, you should apply by writing to Professor Ad Putter, Academic Secretary of the Read-Tuckwell Foundation, at a.d.putter@bristol.ac.uk.

You should provide a brief C.V., a short plan (approximately one side of A4) describing your dissertation thesis and its relation to the theme of immortality, an official transcript of marks (BA and if applicable MA), and you should arrange two letters of reference.

Please ask your referees to send their letters electronically direct to a.d.putter@bristol.ac.uk.

For incoming or current students at the Department of Theology and Religious Studies in Bristol, the application procedure is the same except that any application (and references) should be sent directly to the Subject Lead of Theology and Religious Studies; students are advised to inform the Subject Lead of their intention to apply well ahead of the deadline.
