You are required to take **6 units**. In each Teaching block you will take 40 credits of **Mandatory units** (see below). You therefore need to choose one optional unit (from the table overleaf) in TB1 and one in TB2 - (mark as 1). Please also choose a reserve unit in each teaching block in case we are unable to offer you your first choice – (mark as 2).

If you would like to take Greek and/or Latin as optional units you must specify which level A, B or C (see page 8 of current Departmental handbook for language levels).

The School tries as far as possible to allocate students to their first choice unit(s). However, this is not always possible, depending on the level of demand for a particular course.

MANDATORY UNITS (20 credits each)

Ancient History: You must take Approaches to Ancient History (CLAS22404) and Late Antiquity (CLAS22381) in TB1. You must also take Non-Literary Sources for Ancient History (CLAS22319) and Classical Greece (CLAS22380) in TB2.

Classics: You must take *both* a Greek and a Latin language unit in TB1 and in TB2.
