<p>Membership and advisory work</p> <p><i>Membership or advisory work, including capturing associated event or organisation details</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Membership of external research organisation • Membership or peer review panel or committee • Membership of public/government advisory/policy group or panel • Advisory work for/on panel to industry

<p>Hosting a visitor</p> <p><i>Visit from an individual from another research institution, including capturing details on the visiting external person</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hosting an academic visitor • Hosting a non-academic visitor
<p>Examination</p> <p><i>Examination activities, including capturing the examiner, examined person and/or organisation of examination details</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Examination
<p>Fellowships, Media, and other activities</p> <p><i>Fellowships, Media, and any activities not covered in the other categories</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fellowship awarded competitively • Media coverage or participation • Other activity
