## Self-injury and people with learning disabilities



A one-day conference presenting the findings of a three year research study looking at self-injury and people with learning disabilities. This conference will be of interest to people with learning disabilities and professionals and family/carers supporting people with learning disabilities in the statutory, independent and voluntary sectors.

The conference will look at:

- The experiences, circumstances and emotions of people with learning disabilities who self-injure.
- The reasons why people with learning disabilities self-injure.
- The positive support that people with learning disabilities who self-injure say they want.
- Developing service support, minimising self-injury, emotional literacy and communication.
