Professor Hester holds the Chair in Gender, Violence and International Policy in the School for Policy Studies at the University of Bristol, UK. She has researched many aspects of violence against women and children, including child contact in the context of domestic violence, links between domestic violence and child sexual abuse, same sex domestic abuse, a longitudinal study of gender and domestic violence perpetrators and intervention with male domestic violence perpetrators accessing health services.
