Extra Mural Studies requirements

Pre-clinical EMS

- 12 weeks of pre-clinical EMS during years 1 & 2, made up of 2 weeks each of:
 - Lambing, equine, dairy, small animal, pigs and/or poultry, placement of choice

Clinical EMS

- 26 weeks during years 3,4 & 5
- We recommend 10 weeks of placement in a practice that you intend to return over the three years
