PPL.1Jan22 Aims: to investigate the physiological state of natural torpor in mice and establish if it can be induced in a different mammalian species by replicated by targeted manipulation of relevant neural circuits.	Approved subject to changes – to be re-reviewed by subcommittee

	Harms: use of non-harmful GAA and wildtype animals which may undergo surgical intervention with recovery. Post-surgery testing including exposing animals to modified environments.  Benefits: Fundamental biology with potential to generate information about neural mechanisms associated with the protective state of torpor. Studies will also establish if a mammalian species, which does not naturally develop torpor, will enter a similar physiological state if similar neural circuits are modulated. This would provide proof of concept for the longer-term concept that this could be used to protect patients in ICU.
