### The Process

1. Organise an activity with SME or Employer Engagement team (e.g. [fair/recruitment event etc](#))
2. Complete the [Endorsing Organisation form](#)
3. The Bristol PLUS Award team will contact you to arrange your Endorsing Organisation activity

Your endorsing status will run for one academic year after which time you will have the option to renew.

Deliver a 1 - 2 hour selection process workshop, online or face to face.

Topics include:

Interview skills / Mock assessment centres /  
Presentation skills / Online recruitment test /  
Gamification practice

### Mock Interviews

Deliver mock interviews, online or face to face.

- 3 hour time commitment
- Open to 10 Bristol PLUS Award students
- PLUS Award team provide interview questions

- Minimum preparation required from your organisation
- Equip students with skills to succeed at interview
- In-depth face-face time with a small number of engaged students
- Helps students achieve a PLUS Award activity

Deliver 1 day (4 - 6 hour)\* interactive Hackathon style event to:

- solve a real-life problem for your organisation
- or equip students with a generic employability skill (i.e. leadership / innovation)

Open to 15 - 60 students  
Organised with support of PLUS / SME /
