Location of CRICBristol

The entrance is separate from the main entrance of St Michael's Hospital: the main entrance is directly off St Michael's Hill.

Please press the buzzer of the right-hand door for entrance to CRIC

(the left hand door is Audiology).

Trenchard Street Car Park

With a city centre location, parking is very restricted in the area of CRICBristol. There is limited meter parking on St Michael's Hill and in Bristol Oncology Centre. The nearest multistorey car park is Trenchard Street. Please note that there is a very steep hill between Trenchard St car park and CRICBristol

Travelling to CRICBristol

A free shuttle bus service (HUBS) is provided for visitors and staff of University Hospitals Bristol NHS Trust and the University of Bristol. It provides a link between Bristol Temple Meads train station, the city centre, Bristol General Hospital, the University of Bristol and Bristol Royal Infirmary. The HUBS shuttle bus runs every 15 minutes, and there is a bus stop near CRICBristol on St. Michael's Hill. For further information on this service please visit:

For those travelling from further away, the nearest railway station is Bristol Temple Meads. There are frequent buses between the station and the city centre, including the free HUBS bus service.

First Bus provide a number of bus routes into Bristol. Bristol Bus and Coach Station in Marlborough Street is a few minutes walk away from CRICBristol. Please note there is a very steep hill between Marlborough Street and CRICBristol.
