This child is a participant in The Cleft Collective Speech and Language Study.

The Cleft Collective is the world's largest cleft lip and palate research programme. An initiative of the UK-based charity, the Healing Foundation, the programme was launched in 2012 and includes a birth cohort study. With the help of every cleft team in the UK, up to 3500 children and their families will be recruited over a 3.5 year period. Families will be asked to contribute biological samples (such as saliva) and complete a number of questionnaires at important time points during their child's development.

The Cleft Collective Speech and Language Study is funded by the NIHR and is collecting data on speech and language development in children from birth to three in the birth cohort. It is very important that we know about children's hearing levels during this time given the impact that this could have on a child's speech and language development.

We would be grateful therefore if you could complete the fields on the opposite side of this card to enable us to collect this data, including retrospective data on the newborn hearing screen and other hearing tests that have been carried out to date wherever possible. Parents will give this card to the speech and language therapist when they go to their 3 year assessment who will send it to the Cleft Collective research team where it will be linked to the child's speech and language data.
