

What is a contextual offer?

Our contextual offer is two grades below the standard entry requirements and is made to applicants from groups currently underrepresented at the University of Bristol

You may be eligible for a contextual offer if:

- You have attended an aspiring state school or college (eligibility can be checked online at bristol.ac.uk/contextual-offers), or
- You live in an area with low progression to higher education, or
- You have completed a University of Bristol outreach programme, or
- You have spent time in care, or
- You receive (or have received) free school meals
