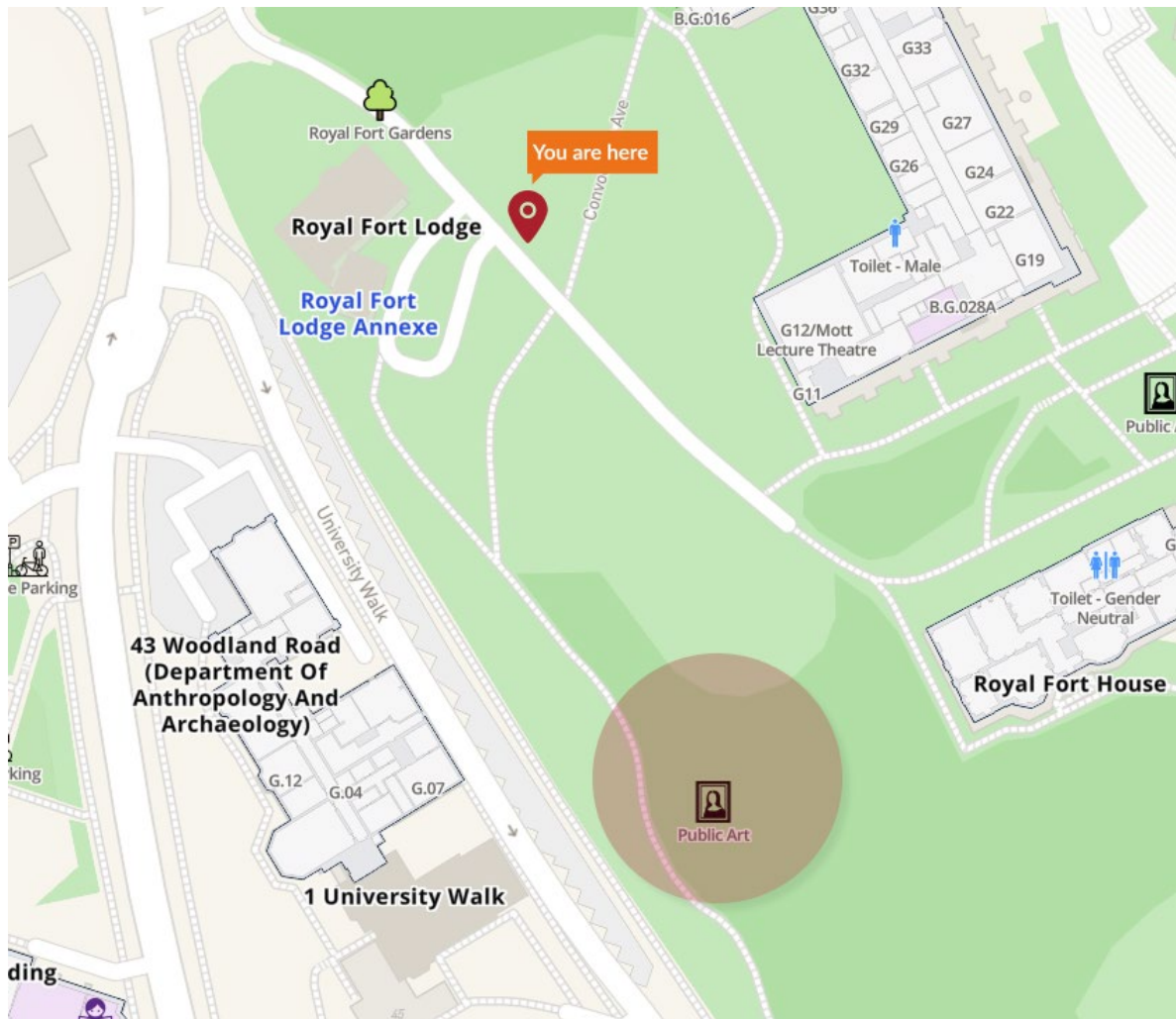
Question 1: In what year were Royal Fort House and its grounds donated to the University?

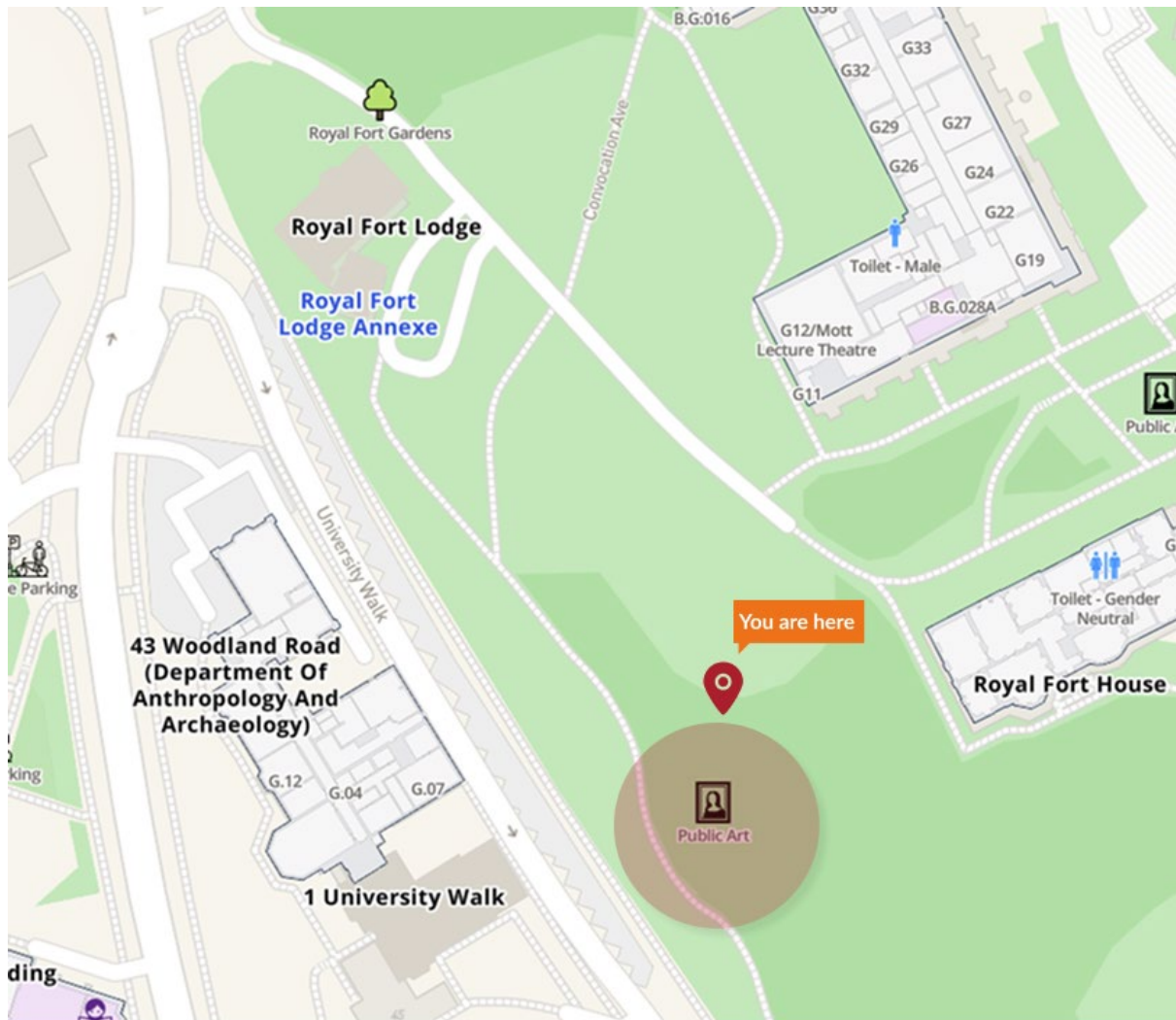

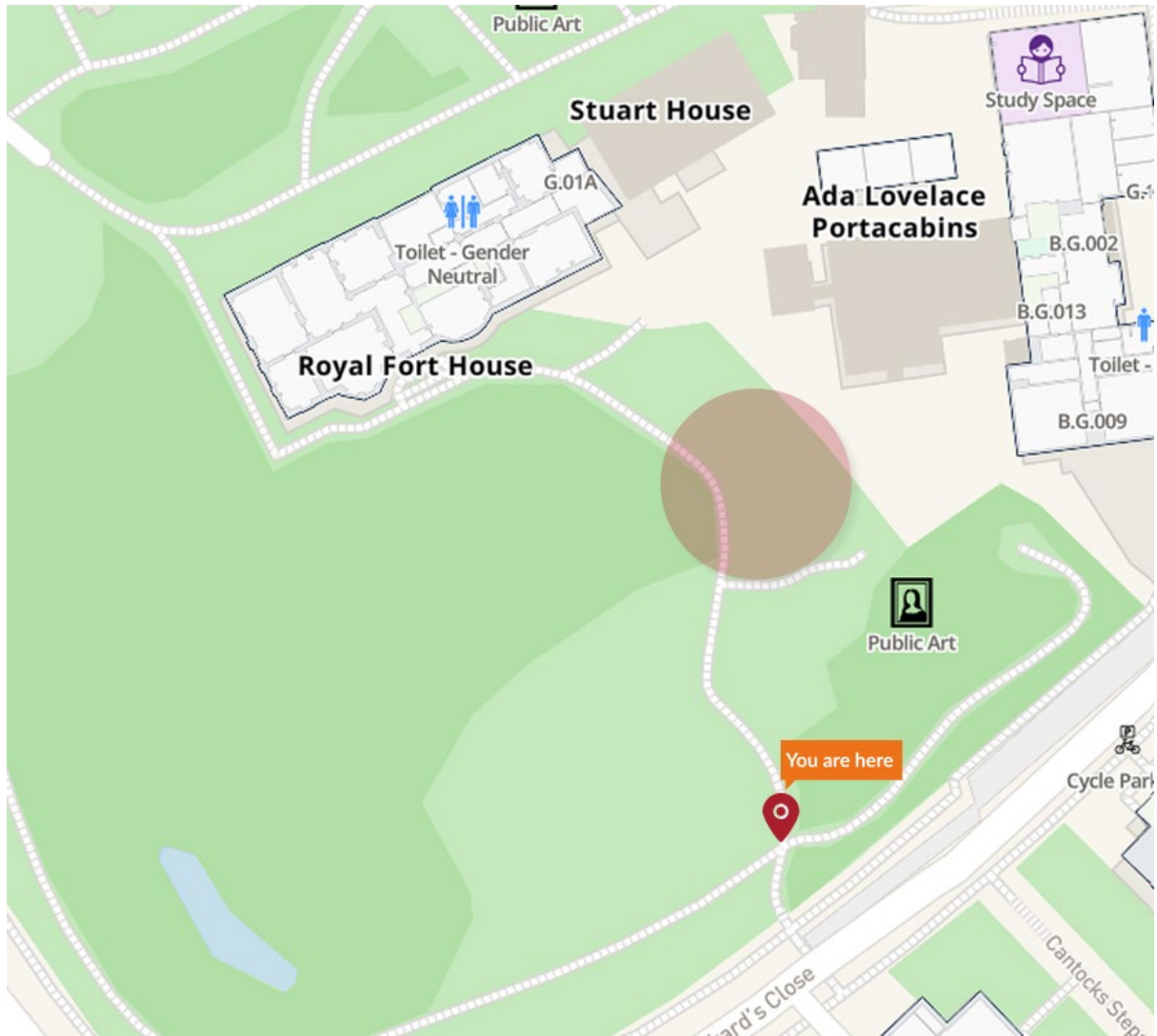

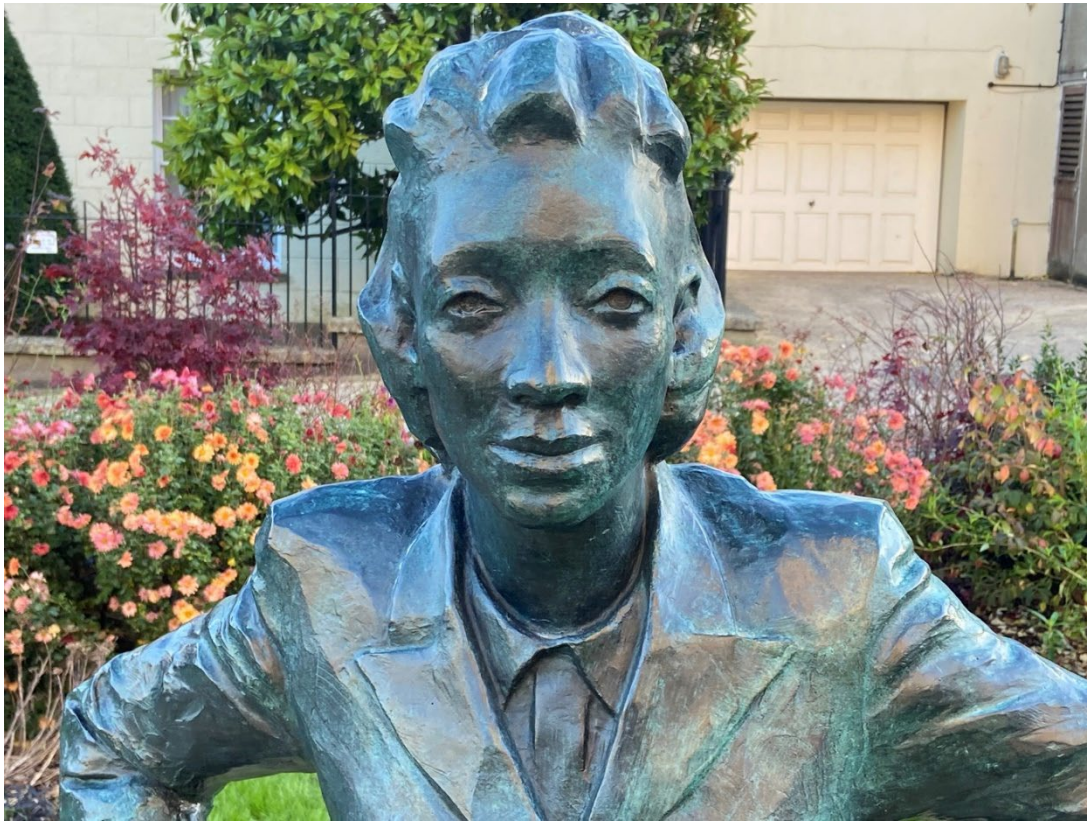

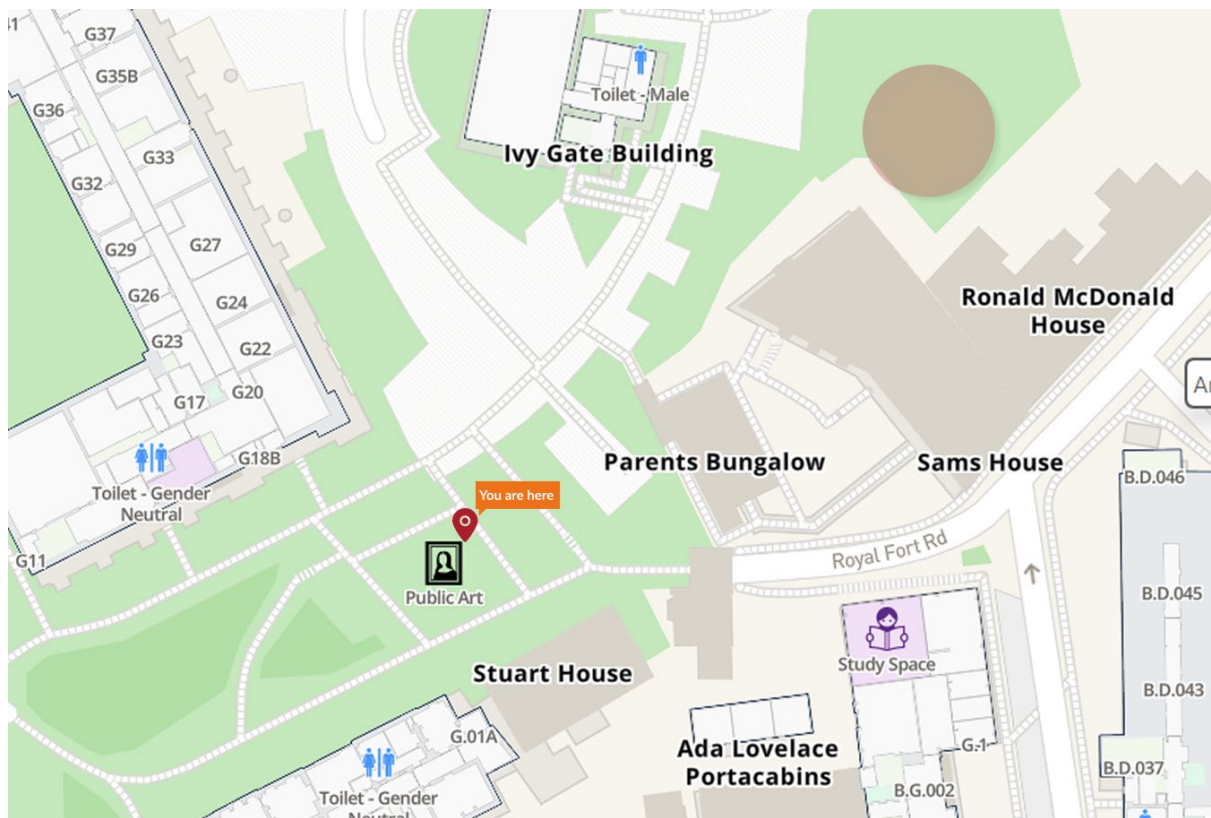

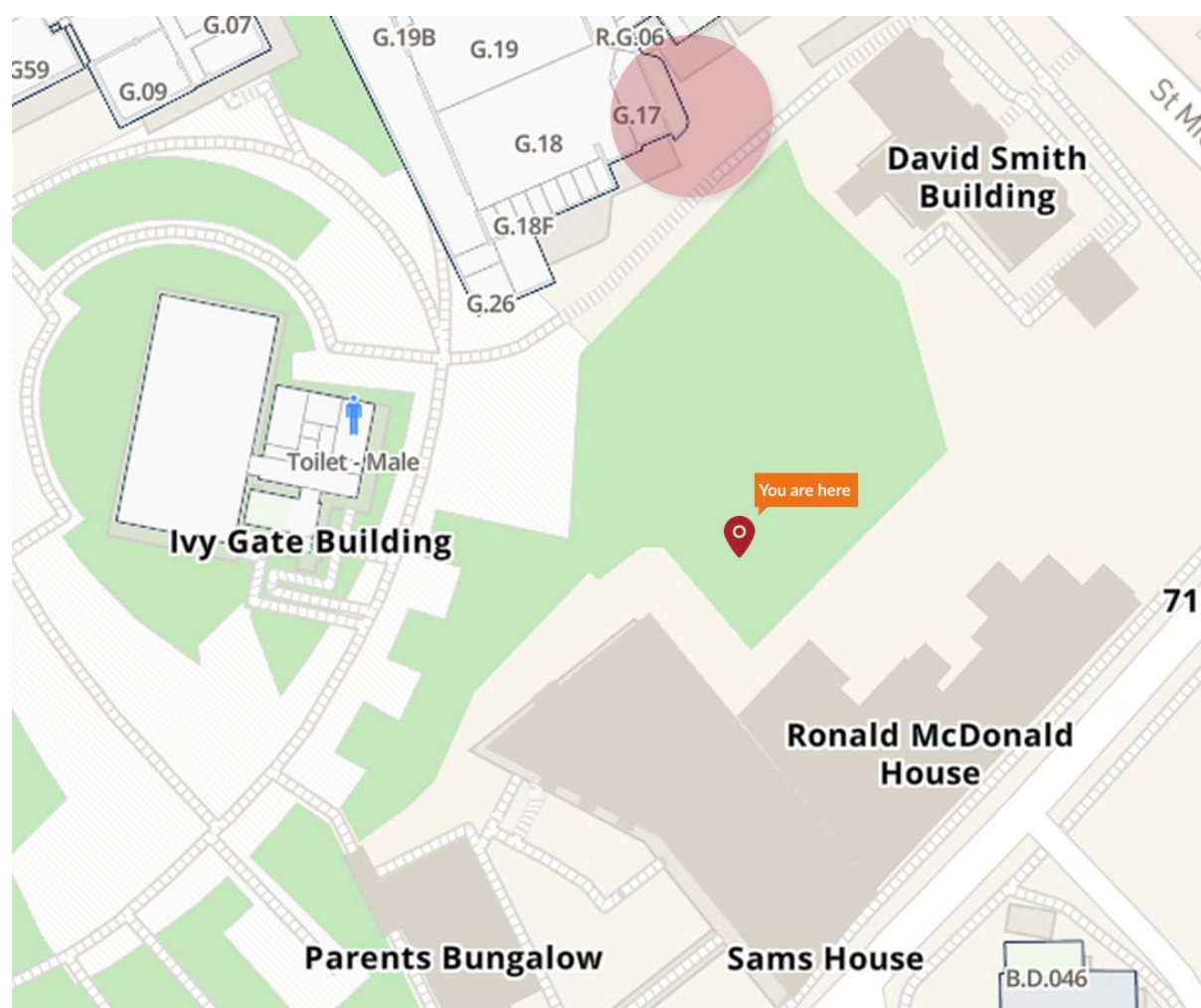

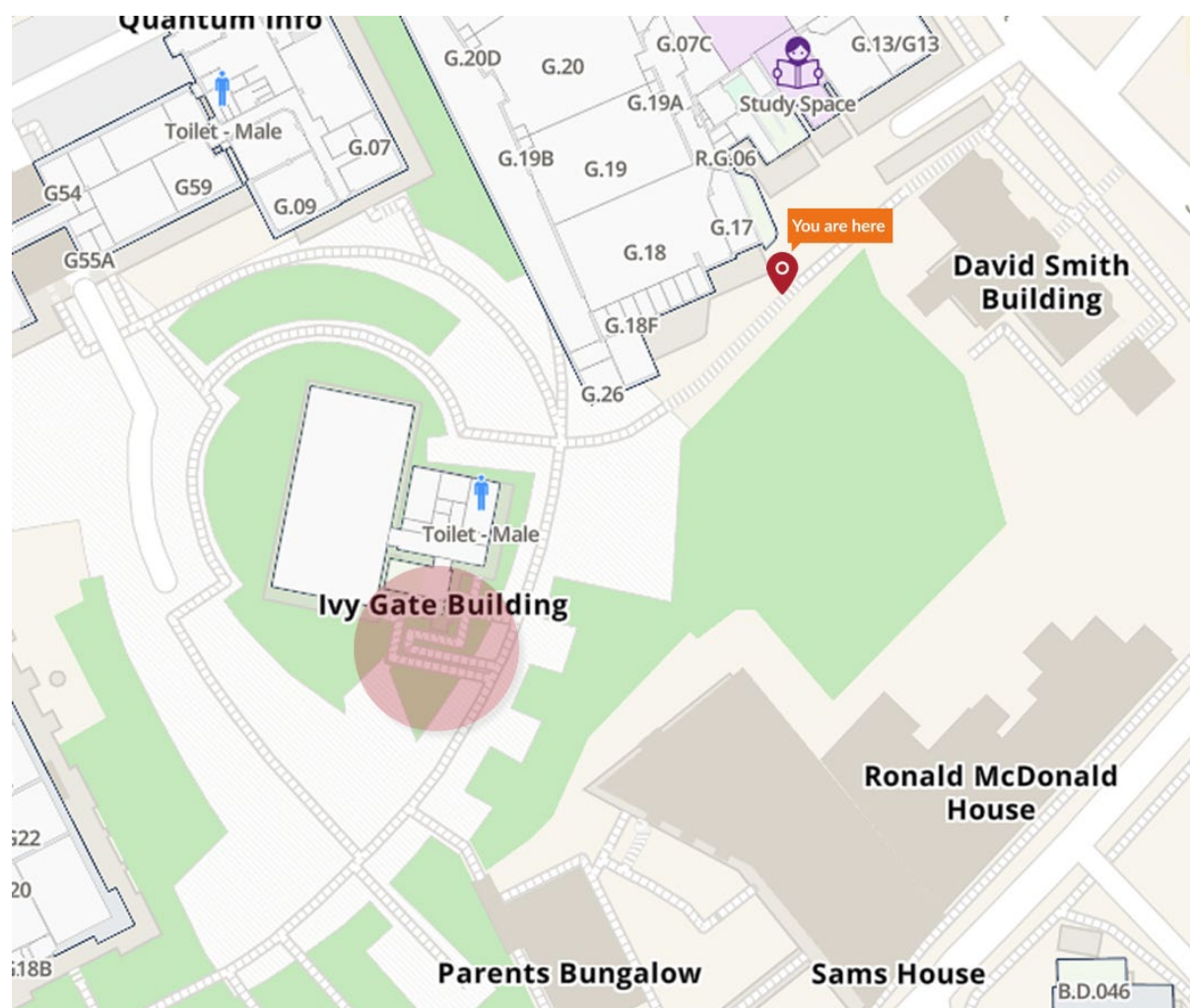

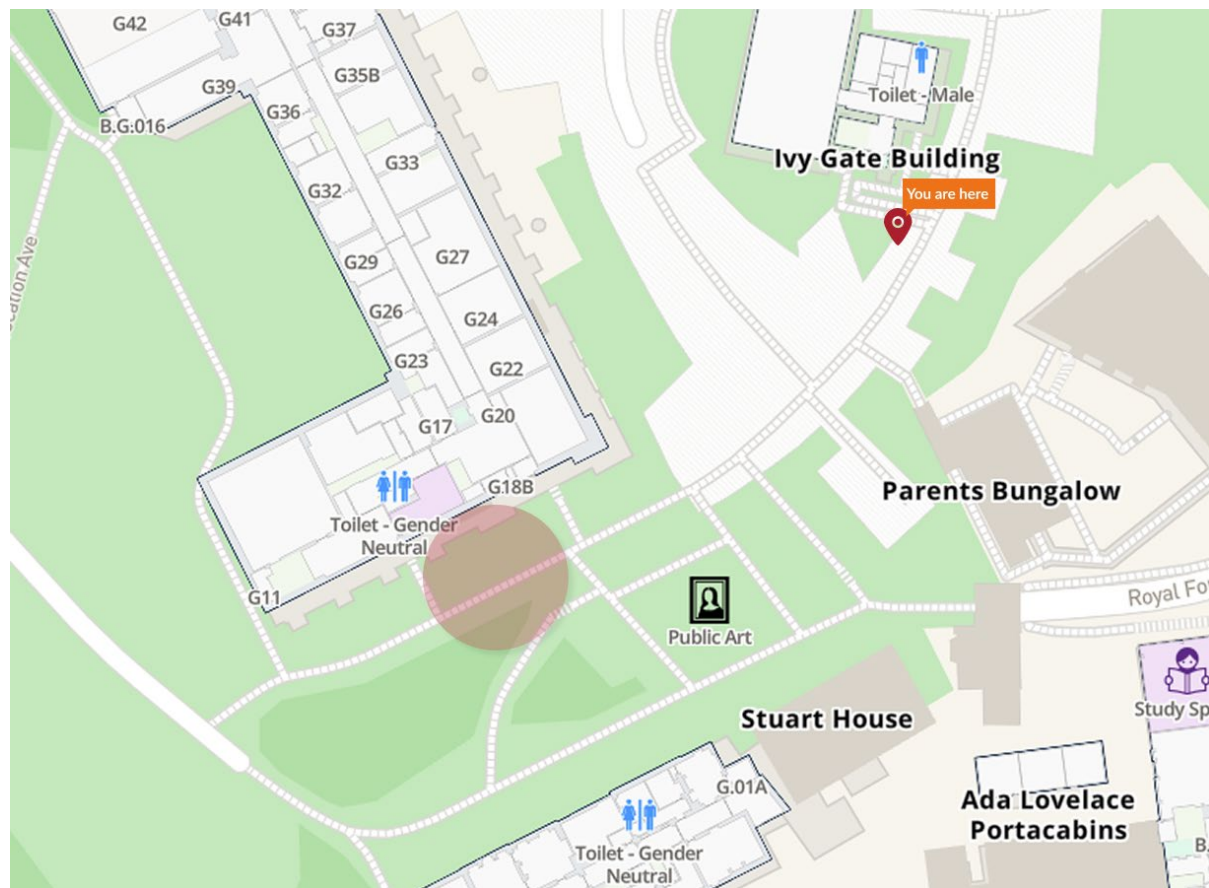
