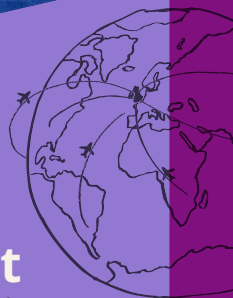

Entry requirements

We accept a wide range of qualifications. You can find specific entry requirements on individual course pages online. The table below will give you an idea of the typical requirements for each study level.

English language requirements

If you are not a national of an English-speaking country (as listed in our English language profiles) you will need to show proof of your English language ability. We accept a wide range of qualifications and tests which are listed on our English language profile pages. Courses have different requirements, and more information can be found on our course pages online.

Degree type	Accepted qualifications	More information
International Foundation Programme	High School Certificate with minimum grade average of 75%. You may be asked to achieve a particular grade in required subjects.	bristol.ac.uk/ifp
Undergraduate (Bachelor's: BA, BEng, BSc, BDS, BVSc, LLB, MArts, MEng, MSci, MBChB)	The University of Bristol International Foundation Programme or an appropriate foundation/bridging programme.	bristol.ac.uk/undergraduate
Postgraduate taught (Master's: MSc, MA, MRes, LLM)	A bachelor's degree of four or five years' duration from a recognised institution, with a minimum grade of 65% or GPA of 3.25. In some instances, we may also require a one or two year master's degree from a recognised institution.	bristol.ac.uk/postgraduate
Postgraduate research (PhD)	A bachelor's degree of four or five years, plus a good master's degree from a recognised institution.	bristol.ac.uk/postgraduate
