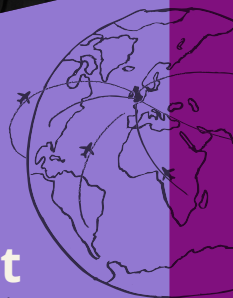

Entry requirements

We accept a wide range of qualifications. You can find specific entry requirements on individual course pages online. The table below will give you an idea of the typical requirements for each study level.

International Foundation Programme	Certificado de Ensino Médio with minimum grade average of 6.5/10 with pass mark of 5; 7.5/10 with pass mark of 6; 8/10 with pass mark of 7. You may be asked to achieve a particular grade in required subjects.	bristol.ac.uk/ifp
Undergraduate (Bachelor's: BA, BEng, BSc, BDS, BVSc, LLB, MArts, MEng, MSci, MBChB)	One of the following: • A successfully completed appropriate foundation/bridging programme • Certificado de Conclusão de Segundo Grau / Certificado de Conclusão de Ensino Medio combined with three AP tests or three IB HL subjects. Subject requirements must be met through AP tests or IB HL subjects • First year of a Brazilian university degree (Licenciado/ Bacharel) from accredited institutions with good grades.	bristol.ac.uk/undergraduate
Postgraduate taught (Master's: MSc, MA, MRes, LLM)	Bacharel/Licenciado (4 years or more in duration) with good marks in a an accredited degree programme.	bristol.ac.uk/postgraduate
Postgraduate research (PhD)	For Science/Engineering degrees: Bacharel/Licenciado (4 years or more in duration) with good marks. For other degrees: Mestre.	bristol.ac.uk/postgraduate
