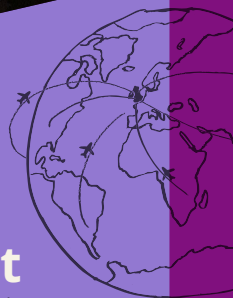

English language requirements

You will need to show proof of your English language ability. We accept a wide range of qualifications and tests which are listed on our English language profile pages. Courses have different requirements, and more information can be found on our course pages online.

Degree type	Accepted qualifications	More information
Undergraduate (Bachelor's: BA, BEng, BSc, BDS, BVSc, LLB, MArts, MEng, MSci, MBChB)	One of the following: • CBSE or CISCE qualifications, typically 80-90% • A-levels: typically AAA or higher • IB diploma: typically 36 points or higher. Other qualifications such as state board certificates are accepted; contact us for details.	bristol.ac.uk/undergraduate
Postgraduate taught (Master's: MSc, MA, MRes, LLM)	First class degree (60% or higher) or first class with distinction from a recognised Indian university; 55% pass may be accepted from some top colleges.	bristol.ac.uk/postgraduate
Postgraduate research (PhD)	First class Indian bachelor's degree and some research experience; master's degree with research elements is desirable.	bristol.ac.uk/postgraduate
Global Transfer Programme (Bachelor's/master's)	If you are a student at one of our partner universities, you may be eligible to apply to Bristol via our Global Transfer Programme. The programme provides guaranteed offers and exclusive funding opportunities.	bristol.ac.uk/transfer
