English language requirements

If you are not a national of an English-

speaking country, you will need to show proof of your English language ability. We accept a wide range of qualifications and tests. You can check the specific English language level required for your course on our online course pages.

You may be eligible to meet English language requirements through SPM/ 1119/CEFR/IGCSE/A-levels/IB English.
