We accept a wide range of qualifications. Our typical requirements are below, and you can find specific entry requirements on our online course pages. Please contact us to check your specific entry requirements and ask any questions before you apply.

English language requirements

If you are not a national of an English-speaking country, you will need to show

proof of your English language ability. We accept a wide range of qualifications and tests. You can check the specific English language level required for your course on our online course pages.

You may be eligible to meet English language requirements through the Singapore Integrated Programme, Singapore Ordinary Level, Singapore Secondary 4 or the Singapore NUS Integrated Diploma.
