How to Collect Your or Your Child's **MouthSwab Sample?**



Important Reminders Before You Begin:

- Allow 5 minutes to complete the mouthswab sample collection
- Please make sure that you (or your child) have no food in your (or their) mouth.
- Have a sharp pair of scissors (not provided in the collection kit).
- Have a clean, flat surface to stand the collection tube on.
- Do not forget to wash your (and/or your child's) hands before and after the collection.
- Please contact us if anything is missing or if you need a replacement kit.

Disclaimer: This collection method is for people aged 3 years and over and should be completed by an adult or under adult supervision.

Warning: The collection tube contains a detergent sample collection liquid. Do not discard or spill it, and do not drink it.

Caution: The mouthswab sticks are a choking hazard for young children. Do not leave your child unattended during the sample collection.

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The mouthswab collection kit should contain the following :

A. Sample return form **B.** Postal Box **C.** Mouthswab sample collection Instruction sheet **D.** Biohazard Bag **E.** Freepost Return envelope **F.** Collection tube **G.** A Mouthswab H. A Stand



Please read all the instructions carefully.

They will help you collect the mouthswab sample correctly.



Step 1

Stand the **Collection tube** into the **stand provided**.

Warning: the collection tube contains a sample collection liquid. Do not discard or spill. Do not drink-contain detergent.



Using sharp scissors, cut off the excess stick so that the swab will fit into the tube when closed.

Step 2

<u>Leave enough length to hold the swab while collecting your sample.</u>

Step 3



Remove the **Mouthswab** from its packaging.

Rub the **Mouthswab** around the inside of the mouth, along the upper and lower gums and on the inside of both cheeks, for around **<u>30-40 seconds</u>**.

Tip: Do not touch the soft head of the mouthswab with your fingers. Please do not open the mouthswab until you need to use it.

Step 4

Place the used **Mouthswab** into the liquid at the bottom of the **Collection tube**.

Tightly close the lid of the **Collection tube**.

Step 5

Please write the date and time you collected the sample onto the **Sample Return** Form.

Return the **Sample Return Form** with your sample in the **Postal Box.**



Step 6

Remove the **Collection tube** from the **stand**.

Then, put it into the **Biohazard Bag** and seal it shut.

Place the **Biohazard Bag**, the completed **Sample Return Form**, and the **Stand** into the **postal box** and close it.

Step 7

Seal plas plas plas plas plas plas plas

Seal the **Postal box** inside the **Freepost return plastic envelope**.

Please return your sample using <u>any</u> Royal Mail post box as soon as possible.

<u>**Tip:**</u>Other samples collected at the same time can be returned in the same packaging.
