UNIVERSITY ENSEMBLES

UNIVERSITY SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA (auditioned)

CONDUCTORS: JOHN PICKARD (AUTUMN TERM); NEAL FARWELL (SPRING TERM)

Rehearsals: Tuesdays 19.00-21.15, Victoria Rooms

This is the University's main orchestra, and it is conducted by members of Music staff. A full-size symphony orchestra, we perform ambitious repertoire from the 19th, 20th and 21st centuries to a high standard. We aim to balance established masterworks, some less well-known pieces and contemporary music. Recent performances have included Shostakovich's 8th Symphony, Rachmaninoff's 2nd Symphony, Mahler's Das Lied von der Erde, and works by contemporary composers, including Augusta Read Thomas, Carmen Ho and Alissa Firsova. Repertoire in the autumn term will feature Holst's Beni Mora Suite, Vaughan Williams's Serenade to Music and the remarkable 2nd Symphony by the Welsh composer Grace Williams.

Bristol University's most prestigious choir, University Singers perform a wide range of music from the Renaissance to present day to a professional standard. The choir consists of around 28 singers and is directed by experienced professional conductor, Elinor Cooper. University Singers perform at least three concerts a year, and are often invited to take part in recordings and other professional opportunities outside the university.

UNIVERSITY CHORUS (no audition)

The University Chorus is open to all staff and students and to anyone associated with the University. There is no audition and anyone can join, though members are expected to be capable of singing from a score and to attend most of the rehearsals. We give a concert every March and participate in the University Christmas Carol Service at the end of the Autumn Term. This year, we will be singing a range of music, from Byrd to Bruckner. You can enrol online (joining fee £15.00 at shop.bris.ac.uk from 18th September). Joining is free for all Department of Music students. Please keep your email receipt as confirmation of enrolment and bring it with you to the first rehearsal so that you can collect your vocal scores. OUR GROUPS:

THE BRISTONES (no audition)

The Bristones is the mixed unauditioned group of the University of Bristol A Cappella Society, which provides everyone with the chance to sing a cappella. With one rehearsal each week, the group allows people of all abilities and experiences to release their inner Pitch Perfect, singing a variety of music! We perform several concerts throughout the year, including Best Of the South West, where we join other talented groups in one big showcase! This is an extremely fun and sociable group, where everyone is welcome, and the ability to read music is not required.

THE TONE RANGERS (no audition)

The Tone Rangers is the unauditioned group for Lower Voice parts; anyone who can hit those low notes is welcome to join in our group!

Top Note is an unauditioned group for the upper voice parts; we welcome everyone who can sing Sopranos and Alto parts – if you can hit those top notes then come along!

- * No previous experience is required and you do not need to be able to read music as teach tracks are provided and other people are always around to help.

ALL SHARPS (auditioned)

All Sharps is a non-competitive A cappella group at the University of Bristol (previously called HotTUBBS) singing a wide variety of music ranging from close-harmony and barbershop to collegiate A cappella. We're made up of members who want a more challenging yet rewarding experience.

- * In previous years we've been national finalists at VoiceFest, runners-up at the Manchester Amateur Choral Competition and winners in two categories at the Mid Somerset Festival.
- * We were semi-finalists at the Voice Festival 2015, showcasing a different style of A cappella to resounding success.
- * We have released our debut EP, Caught Up in a Dream which is on all streaming services!

We are a non-competitive group, meaning that we don't enter competitions such as the ICCAs. As a result, we only have one 2-hour rehearsal a week.

PITCH FIGHT (auditioned)

Pitch Fight is Bristol's auditioned female and non-binary identifying A cappella group. We perform collegiate A cappella versions of anything from Macklemore to Katy Perry. We're looking for strong singers or beatboxers who like to sing, dance and love to perform so come along and audition.

We rehearse for 5 hours a week but the group tend to spend a lot more time together just socialising in and out of the society, so be prepared for your world to turn into a real-life version of Pitch Perfect. AT THE DEPARTMENT OF MUSIC, VICTORIA ROOMS, QUEEN'S ROAD

One single audition covers Symphony Orchestra, Chamber Orchestra and New Music Ensemble; likewise, the University Singers and Chamber Choir. All players and singers (including members of last year's ensembles) need to audition - nobody has an automatic right to a place in any ensemble. This is your **only chance to audition** for the present academic year – places are allocated in the first week. At your audition, you will be asked to perform a short piece of your own choosing and to take a sight-reading test. The piece should be chosen with a view to showing off both technical proficiency and tone quality.

Please note that these are classical music auditions – if you are more interested in popular repertoire, then groups such as A Cappella Society and Music Theatre Bristol will be suitable for you.

SIGN-UP SHEETS will be posted in the Victoria Rooms at the beginning of Welcome Week so you can sign up for an audition. You need to come to the Victoria Rooms in person to do this. You cannot sign up online. If you turn up without having booked a time, you will not be able to audition.
