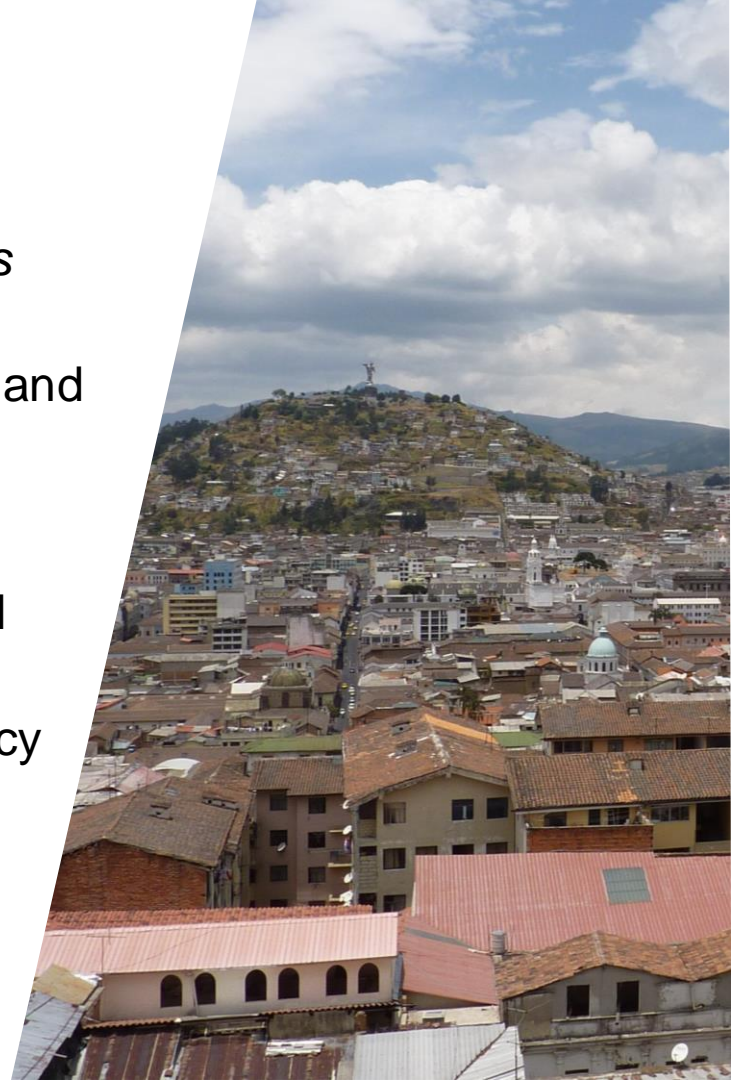
Bristol Poverty Institute (BPI): Introduction

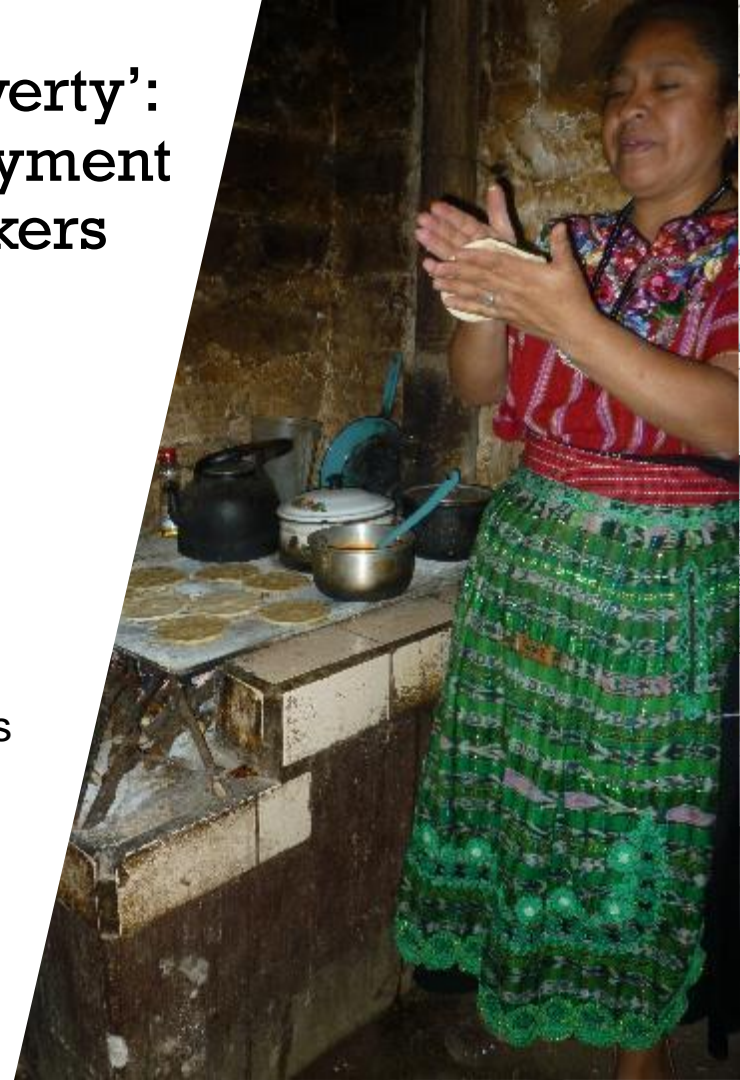
