

School Research Ethics Officers (SREOs) responsibilities:

- Raise and maintain awareness of research ethics in the School, and ensure Faculty and UERC views are disseminated and decisions implemented.
- Provide advice and guidance on ethical concerns and ethical application procedures for example guidance to PhD supervisors.
- Promote best practice in the School.
- Raise issues arising in the School (which require wider consideration) with the FREO.
- Participate and contribute to Faculty and School training as requested.
- Prepare written guidance and instruction for the School on research ethics as appropriate.
- Liaise with other SREOs in the Faculty and meet quarterly with them and the FREO.
- Participate in REC reviews as invited.
