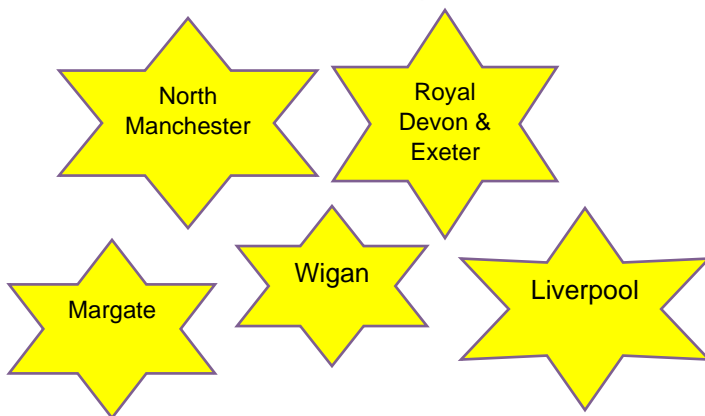

Pre-BRA Study is recruiting well!

With end of recruitment June 2020 in sight, we are actively recruiting and are now more than halfway through! And we are excited! Currently, we are open at **42 sites**, 10 of which have been recruited in the last two months. **And we have over 167 patients in the study!** Not all open sites are recruiting yet. If you have not started with recruitment, we encourage you to get in touch. The first patient was recruited on June 26th 2019 in North Manchester. **Overall, we have 48% of our total recruitment target!** With so many more sites coming on board, we are confident we will reach our target in June 2020. **Thank you all!**

Data Collection: The primary outcome implant loss at 3 months, is now due for some patients.

Thank you very much for completing this in a timely manner. This data point is essential for our data analysis. We will be doing the initial data analysis after we have collected 125 primary outcomes.

3 months data collection: Please complete the CRFs at 3 months. We are allowing an extra month for the 3 months data collection timepoint. This should be collected by 4 months at the latest please. Please can you record the consent and eligibility questions (before the operative data section). These are central teams' records of consent.

REDCap Notes: Please do enter withdrawals and create a CRF for the paper opted questionnaires. The following fields are important for REDCap in order to get the PROMs emailed to patients. Please make sure you answer these questions when you first create the CRFs:

- Questionnaire completion question
- Patient emails
- Actual date of surgery (in section 4, operative data) – NOT planned date of surgery

Please rest assured we are uploading recruitment onto the CPMS system.

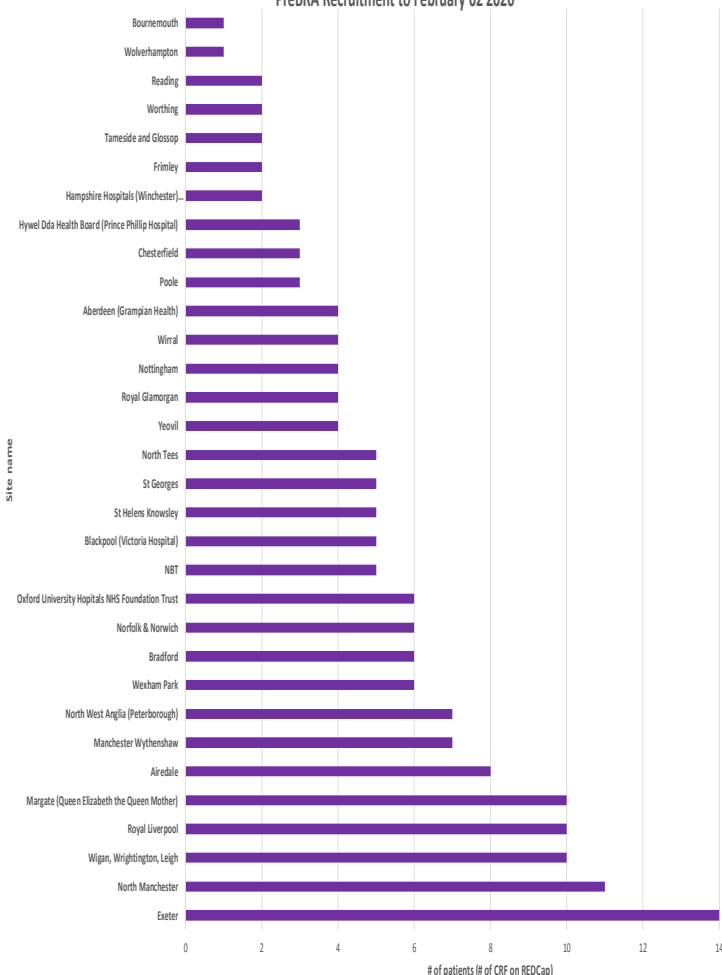
