SCW (South, Central and West Commissioning Support Unit) continues the development on the new web-based platform for the LeDeR programme, to deliver the minimum viable product through a series of agile sprints in the Private Beta phase.

As we enter the Public Beta phase, we will increase user testing to help refine the product. SCW are working closely and effectively with the University of Bristol and NHSE to ensure a smooth transition, including an agreed transition plan and data transfer processes. The new web-based platform will be live by June 2021.
