

Distance travel to work (%)



How do you normally travel to work? (%)









Satisfaction with normal journey home (% satisfied)










Satisfaction with normal journey home (%)












Distance (%)













Awareness of local transport initiatives (%)


Respondents were shown a list of various local transport initiatives and were asked for each if they were aware of them or not and whether they had used them.













Age (%)
