Ashley Down	AD	Studies of parking capacity in the area will be carried out in 2014, but the scheme will not be taken forward to consultation without approval from the Council's Cabinet.
Ashton	AN	Studies of parking capacity in the area will be carried out in 2014, but the scheme will not be taken forward to consultation without approval from the Council's Cabinet.
Bower Ashton	BA	Formal consultation is planned for late 2013/early 2014
Bedminster East	BE	Studies of parking capacity are currently being carried out in the area to enable an initial proposal for the area to be developed. Once this has been completed, pre-statutory consultation stage will be carried out.
Bishopston	BN	Studies of parking capacity in the area will be carried out in 2014, but the scheme will not be taken forward to consultation without approval from the Council's Cabinet.
Bedminster West	BW	Studies of parking capacity in the area will be carried out in 2014, but the scheme will not be taken forward to consultation without approval from the Council's Cabinet.
Clifton East	CE	Consultation closes Friday 29 November 2013.
Cliftonwood and Hotwells	CH	Formal consultation is planned for late 2013/early 2014
Cotham	CM	The Cotham residents' parking scheme became operational from 1 December 2012.
Cotham North	CN	BCC currently advertising final proposals. Consultation will end on Thursday, November 28 2013.
Clifton Village	CV	Formal consultation is planned for early 2014.
Easton and St Philips	ES	The residents' parking scheme for parts of Easton and St Philips has the go-ahead. The new scheme is expected to be live in March 2014.
Kingsdown	KN	The Kingsdown residents' parking scheme (RPS) started in January 2011. Consultation on the Kingsdown area boundary

		extension closed on 5 <sup>th</sup> April 2013.
Montpelier	MR	Studies of parking capacity are currently being carried out in the area to enable an initial proposal for the area to be developed. Once this has been completed, pre-statutory consultation stage will be carried out.
Redland	RD	Formal consultation is planned for late 2013/early 2014.
Redcliffe	RE	The Redcliffe RPS became operational from Thursday 1 November 2012.
St Andrews	SA	Studies of parking capacity in the area will be carried out in 2014, but the scheme will not be taken forward to consultation without approval from the Council's Cabinet.
Southville	SE	Studies of parking capacity are currently being carried out in the area to enable an initial proposal for the area to be developed. Once this has been completed, pre-statutory consultation stage will be carried out.
Spike Island	SI	Studies of parking capacity are currently being carried out in the area to enable an initial proposal for the area to be developed. Once this has been completed, pre-statutory consultation stage will be carried out.
St Pauls	SP	Consultation on an initial proposal for the area was carried out last summer. The plans are currently being finalised before being taken forward to statutory consultation.
St Werburghs	SW	Studies of parking capacity in the area will be carried out in 2014, but the scheme will not be taken forward to consultation without approval from the Council's Cabinet.
Totterdown	TN	Studies of parking capacity in the area will be carried out in 2014, but the scheme will not be taken forward to consultation without approval from the Council's Cabinet.
Windmill Hill	WH	Studies of parking capacity in the area will be carried out in 2014, but the scheme will not be taken forward to consultation without approval from the Council's Cabinet.
