In the heart of Clifton, nestled behind high stone walls on Constitution Hill lies a magnificent 10-acre eighteenth century garden which showcases an Orangery, Steam Tower, Rotunda and what is believed to be the most exotic and best-preserved shell grotto in the entire country.

The glistening shell-lined grotto, famous Orangery and 10-acre ornamental gardens, full of secrets & surprises, have everything you need to ensure you have the wedding of your dreams. Outdoor ceremonies provide couples with options of flexible layouts and the peace and tranquillity of using a private outdoor space. They also include use of white folding chairs for up to 110 as shown in the image on the next page.

In 1714 Goldney House (formerly known as Goldney Hall) was erected by Thomas Goldney III. In 1864 the traditional Georgian design of the house was altered by eminent Victorian architect Alfred Waterhouse, who also designed the Natural History Museum. Whether it is the grandeur of Goldney House, or the stunning 10-acre gardens, Goldney House & Gardens has everything you need to make sure you have the most unique and unforgettable day.

CIVIL CEREMONIES

Goldney House is licensed to hold civil ceremonies in a variety of areas, both inside and out.

Couples are able to exchange vows under an arc of 14 Yew trees in our eighteenth-century Goldney Garden. These were likely planted at the time Thomas Goldney III developed the garden in the late eighteenth century and are one of the oldest features of the gardens.

Included with an outdoor ceremony is chair hire for up to 110.

CLIFTON HILL HOUSE & THE MAHOGANY PARLOUR

Clifton Hill House is a Grade 1 listed Palladian Villa and an excellent indoor option for larger ceremonies. Located on just the other side of Constitution Hill. Located just a 2 minute walk away from Goldney House, The two spaces - Drawing Room or Reception Room can host up to 80 guests for a civil ceremony. The space boasts large sash windows overlooking beautiful gardens and views out to Brandon Hill.

The Mahogany Parlour is an intimate ceremony room for up to 40 guests located inside Goldney House. This stunning space has a highly decorative ceiling designed by Alfred Waterhouse, ornate wooden carvings and looks out over the extensive Goldney Gardens.

INTIMATE CEREMONIES

For couples looking for a more intimate gathering we offer Monday to Thursday ceremony-only options.

Couples can have an intimate ceremony in our Rotunda which holds up to 12 people.

The Mahogany Parlour, Goldney Gardens, Drawing Room, Reception Room are also available for intimate ceremonies from Monday to Thursday.

The Orangery can cater for up to 110 guests for your wedding breakfast. This reception space is light and airy with exceptional garden views and neutral décor to suit all tastes.

As the day moves into night, additional guests are welcome to join you to celebrate and dance the night away. The Orangery can host up to 150 guests for the evening reception.



THE GROTTTO

Astonish your guests with an unforgettable trip to Goldney's infamous shell-lined grotto. Originally constructed in 1764 it is believed to be the best preserved grotto in the UK.

If you opt for the grotto upgrade during your drinks reception, guests will face a lion's den lit by skylights on entering the intricate cavern.

With over 200 different types of shell and Bath stone the grotto harbours many more secrets & revelations.

When hiring the grotto for your drinks reception, a trained and knowledgeable member of our team will be on hand to provide further history about the grotto and grounds to further amaze your guests

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I book a registrar for the ceremony?

Contact Bristol City Council. You can call them on: 01179 222 800 for rates and availability

Do you offer any accommodation?

We do not have any on-site accommodation however we have strong connections to local hotels who offer us preferential rates. Please contact your Wedding Coordinator for a list of hotels.

Is crockery, cutlery & linen included in the hire?

Cutlery, crockery, white table linen and napkins are all provided as standard within the menu pricing. Items such as upgraded glassware, crockery and charger plates would be at an additional cost.

Can we decorate?

Yes absolutely! The Orangery has a timeless neutral décor which works with all colour palettes. You and your suppliers are welcome to come in from 10am on the day of your wedding to set-up and decorate the inside and outside spaces and really make the venue feel personalised to you. We do ask however that you please do not attach anything to the walls or fittings which could cause damage to the paintwork.

Can I bring garden games?

Yes absolutely, lawn games such as boules, giant Jenga and croquet are all perfect entertainment during your drinks reception.

Can I bring my own DJ/band?

Yes – you provide your own entertainment. We allow bands of up to 5 members. We require DJs and bands to have PAT testing, public liability & risk assessment documents. They would need to be an approved supplier. Please contact your wedding coordinator with details of who you would like to book prior to confirming the entertainment.

How can I get to you?

Car: we can provide you with 2 car parking spaces on the day. The nearest NCP car park is approximately a 6-minute walk.

Bus: We're approximately a 4-minute walk from the closest bus stop

Walk: We're just outside of Bristol City Centre and only a short walk from the Triangle

Train: Bristol Temple Meads is around 15 minutes by car or 20 minutes by bus.
